# **FUTURE TENSE**

## SIMPLE FUTURE TENSE

Helping verbs: Will, Shall

Affirmative: Subject + will/ shall+ Main Verb 1<sup>st</sup> form + Object. Interrogative: will/shall+Subject + Main verb 1<sup>st</sup> form + Object +? Negative: Subject + will/shall + not +Main verb 1<sup>st</sup> form + object.

Ex.1

Aff: John will reach here tomorrow.

Int: Will John reach here tomorrow?

Neg: John will not reach here tomorrow.

Ex.2

Aff: We shall organise a cricket tournament next week. Int: Shall we organise a cricket tournament next week? Neg: We shall not organise a cricket tournament next week.

#### **FUTURE CONTINUOUS TENSE**

Helping Verbs: Will, Shall

Affirmative: Subject + will/shall+be+ Main Verb 1<sup>st</sup> form + ing + Object. Interrogative: will/shall +Subject + be+Main verb 1<sup>st</sup> form + ing + Object +? Negative: Subject + will/shall + not +be+Main verb 1<sup>st</sup> form + ing + object.

Ex: 1

Aff: They will be watching a new movie tonight.

Int: Will they be watching a new movie tonight?

Neg: They will not be watching a new movie tonight.

Ex.2

Aff: I shall be joining music classes next month. Int: Shall I be joining music classes next month? Neg: I shall not be joining music classes next month.

### **FUTURE PERFECT TENSE**

Helping Verbs: will \
have
Shall /

Affirmative: Subject + will/ shall+have+ Main Verb 3<sup>rd</sup> form + Object. Interrogative: will/shall+Subject +have+ Main verb 3<sup>rd</sup> form + Object +? Negative: Subject + will/shall + not + have +Main verb 3<sup>rd</sup> form + object.

Ex.

Aff: They will have completed their exam by the end of this week.

Int: Will they have completed their exam by the end of this week?

Neg: They will not have completed their exam by the end of this week.

### **FUTURE PERFECT CONTINUOUS TENSE**

Helping Verbs: will \
Have +been
Shall /

Affirmative: Subject + will/shall+ have + been + Main Verb 1<sup>st</sup> form + ing+ object +(since/for) + timing + by + timing.

Interrogative: Will/shall+ Subject+have + been +Main Verb 1<sup>st</sup> form + ing + object + (since/for) + timing + by + timing + ?

Negative: Subject + will/shall+ not + have +Been + Main Verb 1<sup>st</sup> form + ing + object + (since/for) +Timing + by + timing.

Ex:

Aff: He will have already been studying in London for three years by next December. Int: Will he have already been studying in London for three years by next December? Neg: He will not have already been studying in London for three years by next December.
